#### **Prevention of Urinary Stones with Hydration (PUSH) Study Opens to Nationwide Remote Recruitment**

The NIDDK [Urinary Stone Disease Research Network \(USDRN\)](#) is conducting the PUSH study (NCT03244189) to assess the effect of behavioral incentives and a smart water bottle to improve adherence to fluid intake for stone prevention. Patients 12+ years can enroll and participate in study procedures remotely and continue clinical care locally.

#### **Save the Date: Drug Development in NMIBC from Scientific, Regulatory, Clinician, and Patient Perspectives**

The fourth annual Johns Hopkins Greenberg Bladder Cancer Institute/AUA Bladder Cancer Translational Research Symposium will be held [virtually on March 4-6, 2021](#). This meeting will provide a critical overview of the various treatment modalities for non-muscle-invasive bladder and upper urinary tract cancer, key aspects to non-clinical and clinical drug development in this disease, and emerging knowledge regarding the genomic immunobiologic underpinnings of treatment response and resistance. This information will help practitioners
