#### **Collaborating for the Advancement of Interdisciplinary Research in Benign Urology (CAIRIBU) Funding Opportunity**

The National Institute of Diabetes & Digestive & Kidney Diseases (NIDDK) is pleased to announce a new funding opportunity from the [Collaborating for the Advancement of Interdisciplinary Research in Benign Urology \(CAIRIBU\)](#) consortium. Applications should relate to the research objectives of either the University of Wisconsin-Madison or University of Pittsburgh George M. O'Brien Cooperative Urology (U54) Centers. Before developing a proposal, prospective applicants should discuss their ideas with the Principal Investigator at the Center to which they apply. Collaborative and interdisciplinary proposals, especially those that embrace CAIRIBU's research goals are especially requested. Each award allows up to \$100,000 per year in direct costs for a maximum of two years. **The application deadline is February 26, 2021.**

#### **Awards for Scientific or Language Edits of a Scientific Manuscript or Grant Proposal**

**Justice, Equity, Diversity and Inclusion (JEDI) awards**, provided by the [Life Science Editors Foundation \(LSEF\)](#), provide free scientific or language edits of a scientific manuscript or grant proposal. Five awards are

available each month for scientists who face disproportionately high and unfair obstacles to career progression in academic science, including but not limited to women, people from historically underrepresented races or ethnic groups, people from low socioeconomic backgrounds, people with disabilities, primary caregivers, people who identify as LGBTQ+, and people in a low or lower middle income country. Graduate students, postdocs, and principal investigators (tenure-track/early-career researchers) are eligible to apply. **The next application deadline is March 10, 2021.**
