### **Committee Makeup**

The Medical Student Education Committee (MSEC) consists of approximately 8 members recommended by the Chair. Members include at least one individual from each of the Urologic subspecialties (including oncology, female urology and pediatrics), and a Urology resident. Members serve 3-year terms (renewable once). Additionally, two medical student representatives, a DE&I Committee Representative and an Society of Academic Urologists (SAU) Representative will serve as non-voting consultants.

### **Vision/Mission/Purpose**

To advocate for urologic education in medical schools by promoting core principles and practices in urology. The Committee will identify important subjects and content and provide a variety of resources to enhance the Medical Student Education in Urology, including educational outlines, multimedia materials, and mentoring tools. The Committee will also ensure that these materials are promoted as effectively as possible to medical schools.

### **Committee Meetings**

Members are required to participate in approximately two weekday teleconferences annually (1-1.5 hours per call), plus one weekend or weekday teleconference (2-3 hours) in March/April for annual strategic planning. Members may also participate on various Education Council subcommittees if requested, to help drive the educational format and course offerings for AUA membership.

### **Time Commitment**

*Chair:*                    30-40 hours annually  
*Member:*                15-25 hours annually

### **Responsibilities**

*Chair:*                    The Chair will attend, organize (with the AUA Staff Liaison) and direct committee meetings, either in person or via teleconference. The Chair should encourage new projects and assign tasks to members as needed. The Chair will be a member of the Education Council.

*Members:*              Members must demonstrate a willingness to serve on the committee and serve as experts for subspecialty educational material contained in the Medical Student Curriculum. Members should be available to edit and augment assigned curriculum sections as assigned, and to provide assistance on projects undertaken by the Committee. Committee members actively contribute and review resources for the AUA Medical Student Education Website.

### **Compliance**

Positions on Councils, Committees, Editorial Boards and Practice Guidelines Panels are open to AUA members in good standing. **Criteria for Selecting New Members**

- Criteria by member category
  - Urologists - Expertise in a urologic specialty contained in the Medical Student Curriculum.
  - Resident - Interested in academic urology.
  - Medical Students - Interested in urology.
- Excellent written communication skills able to review and revise educational resources within the Medical Student Curriculum.
- So that the AUA is in compliance with ACCME Standards, Members of Office of Education committees are not permitted to have financial relationships with ineligible companies (formerly commercial interests) that the ACCME would deem to be that of an owner or employee. Owners are defined as individuals who have an ownership interest in a company, except for stockholders of publicly traded companies, or holders of shares through a pension or mutual fund. Employees are defined as individuals hired to work for another person or business (the employer) for compensation and who are subject to the employer's direction as to the details of how to perform the job.

**Criteria for Selecting Next Chair**

The Chair should have exceptional organizational, communication, and leadership skills. The next chair is selected from existing or former committee members. Chairs are chosen from current or past committee members and are selected by the Education Chair.
