\* Dues for **Resident/Fellow** members in these Category B and C countries are stratified according to their World Bank classification level classification. **Resident/Fellow members** in Category A countries pay the standard Resident/Fellow membership dues of \$115. **Active/Associate** members at any level in these countries pay the standard membership dues of \$555 and are required to also be members of their AUA Section. Each Section is chartered by the AUA as a separate corporate entity with membership dues separate from the AUA (not included in the dues amount listed above).

† Dues for these **Active/Associate** members are stratified according to their World Bank classification level **and include AUA Section membership dues** (Active/Associate members are required to be members of their AUA Section, which are chartered by the AUA as separate corporate entities with dues separate from the AUA). Dues for **Resident/Fellow** members in these Category B and C countries are also stratified according to their World Bank classification levels. **Resident/Fellow** members in these Category A countries pay the standard Resident/Fellow membership dues fee of \$115.
